### 3. proper \_\_\_\_\_ of God’s gifts (the bible, the church & Jesus)

“Whenever the living creatures give glory, honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne and who lives for ever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall down before Him... and worship Him... they lay their crowns before the throne and say: ‘You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for You created all things, and by Your will they were created and have their being.’” Revelation 4:9-11

“In a loud voice they sang: ‘Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!’ Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, singing: ‘To Him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!’ The four living creatures said, ‘Amen,’ and the elders fell down and worshipped.” Revelation 5:12-14

“Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—saying with a loud voice, ‘Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water.’” Revelation 14:6-7 <sup>NKJV</sup>

### 6. the w \_\_\_\_\_ of God

“Then I heard a mighty voice from the temple sanctuary saying to the seven angels, ‘Go and empty out on the earth the seven bowls of God’s wrath and indignation.’” Revelation 16:1 <sup>AMP</sup>

### 7. p \_\_\_\_\_

“I heard a loud voice shout from the throne: ‘God’s home is now with His people. He will live with them, and they will be His own. Yes, God will make His home among His people. He will wipe all tears from their eyes, and there will be no more death, suffering, crying, or pain. These things of the past are gone forever.’ Then the One sitting on the throne said: ‘I am making everything new. Write down what I have said. My words are true and can be trusted.’” Revelation 21:3-5 <sup>CEV</sup>
